## **SURVIVING SPOUSE**

Under Ohio law, a surviving spouse can take title to an unlimited number of passenger vehicles, boats, and motors that are titled to a deceased spouse. Total value of \$65,000.00 or less. Vehicles cannot be slated to be disposed of in a will. If there is an open lien on the vehicle, that lien will be carried forward onto the surviving spouse's title. Titles can be issued even if original title is not available.

## WITH RIGHTS OF SURVIVORSHIP (WROS)

Title can only be in two individuals' names. They are considered co-owners. At the time one of the owners is deceased, the other owner can have the title put into just their name by presenting the title, death certificate, and their ID and Social Security Card.

## TRANSFER ON DEATH

Allows a sole owner of a titled vehicle to designate a single or multiple beneficiaries to receive the vehicle upon the death of the owner. Does not change the ownership of the vehicle. Upon the death of the owner, the beneficiary(ies) will apply for a title in their name. Any liens that may exist on the sole owner's title will move to the new beneficiary's title.
