CROP ROTATION TO FARMLAND APPROVED – ROSS COUNTY-SHOEMAKER AIRPORT FARMLAND

Les Herringa, Beck's Hybrids, met with the commissioners to discuss crop rotation on the Ross County-Shoemaker Airport Farm.

Mr. Herringa said that he understood there were stipulations on the airport farmland due to the airport runway. We dropped soybeans last year and would like to plant corm this year.

Mr. Corcoran said that 530 feet from centerline of the runway to the edge and 1,000 feet on each end need to be considered. There is an issue with deer and coyotes hiding in the corn then appear on the runway when planes are approaching.

Mr. Herringa said that he would stay 550 feet and would be putting in corn in the back portion and not up close to the runway.

Mr. Corcoran also said that this farm would go up to bid this year in September for a new three year term.

Mr. Neal moved, Mr. Garrett seconded, that the Ross County Board of Commissioners, that corn shall be permitted to be grown on the farmland located at the Ross County-Shoemaker Airport, currently lease by Beck's Hybrids, with crop boundary restrictions of 530 feet from the centerline of the runway and 1,000 feet at both ends of the runway, commencing February 12, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018.

Mr. Neal moved, Mr. Garrett seconded, that the Ross County Board of Commissioners, authorized the Devon Shoemaker, Ross County Planning Department, to sign and submit a letter designating Ohio Regional Development Corporation (ORDC), as the Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program (CHIP) PY 2018 consultant for Ross County.

SUBJECTS BROUGHT BEOFRE THE BOARD

Dennis Carr, Fluor-B & W Portsmouth, LLC and Jeff Wagner, met with the commissioners to discuss facility updates.

Mr. Carr said that safety is very good. We have had 2 million safe work hours to report. Clean up continues on 326 and we are finishing up top floor. This will be done in May of 2018. The FY 2019 budget comes out today. We are hopeful the site will be funded 41 million for onsite disposal for 2019.

Mr. Wagner said that we had 3,000 kids receive gifts for Christmas. The Science Bowl this year is in March and being held at Shawnee State University. The United Way was very successful this year.

Richard Shanks, Ray Schinkle and Jhonetta Pulver, Ross County Veterans Commission met with the commissioners to consider the compensation of a public employee’s retirement. Mr. Shanks submitted a letter (ON FILE CORRESPONDENCE) as part of the record for today’s meeting.

Mr. Shanks said that Ms. Pulver started employment with the county when OPERS offered health insurance to retirees at no cost. When Medicare became mandatory she still had the option of health insurance at no cost. She had some Medicare eligibility from prior employment but not enough. No that she is close to retirement, she must look to Medicare as her most affordable insurance. She needs at least three more years.

Mr. Neal said that I remember that every county had to make a decision. We should check into this and let you know.


