
**OTHER BUSINESS**

**Sheriff Lavender – ARPA Funding** – The Sheriff received a letter from one of his staff requesting premium pay for employees that worked on the front lines during the pandemic. The amount of pay per person requested is \$1,500.00. The Sheriff estimates the number of staff this would apply to is, approximately 105-111 persons, costing approximately \$166,500.00. The Commissioners will take this under advisement to determine if this is a viable option for us of the American Recovery Funds.


**Zack Space Affordable Housing** – Mr. Space, Mr. Drabold, Mr. Kostival, and Mr. Tom Simons, appeared before the Commissioners to talk about Sunday Creek Horizons, a full service firm, helping to bring thousands of affordable workforce housing units to central Ohio. Sunday Creek has partnered with Woda Cooper Companies to help communities in Appalachian Ohio leverage their American Rescue Plan monies to build safe, clean, new and fixed-rent workforce housing throughout Appalachian communities.


