ADOPT U.S. TREASURY'S FINAL RULE AND CHOOSE STANDARD ALLOWANCE FOR REVENUE LOSS UP TO \$10 MILLION FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 (ARPA) FUNDS
RESOLUTION 015-22

WHEREAS, in response to the economic fall-out caused by the COVID 19 pandemic, Ross County has received American Rescue Plan Act funds (ARPA) for 2021/2022, and said funds are to be distributed to local entities to provide relief to address the continued impact of COVID-19 on the economy; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing all options from the January 6, 2022, publication from the U.S. Treasury regarding the Final Rule for the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) , which takes effect on April 1, 2 022, this Board has made a determination to move forward by taking advantage of its flexibilities and simplifications now; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board of Ross County Commissioners does hereby adopt the U.S. Treasury's Final Rule and chooses the Standard Allowance for revenue loss up to \$10 million for ARPA funds.

CONTRACT AGREEMENT – RE ENTRY COALITION

The Commissioners agree to engage the Contractor as an independent contractor to monitor Coalition outcomes to assure that strategic objectives are being achieved. The parties have independently examined the relationship between them and have concluded that Contractor is acting as an independent contractor in the performance of the work under this agreement. Nothing in this agreement shall be construed to create an employer-employee relationship between the Commissioners and the Contractor. Contractor is and shall remain an independent contractor in Contractor's relationship with the Commissioners.

CHIP Monitoring Report – The Commissioners are in receipt of the CHIP Monitoring Report from the Ohio Department of Development. Ross County completed their CHIP Program grant with good results. The project files were well-maintained and contained the required documentation. The units inspected showed the work measures performed were of good quality. The rehabilitation specialist had good oversight of the contractors and the work they completed. The homeowners present during the inspections expressed their pleasure with the work completed on their homes. OCD would like to thank Joanne Price and Mark Lahna for their time and attention during this monitoring visit and look forward to working with Ross County in the future.


