[7] Be advised, Open cutting of pavement shall not be permitted unless the Ross County Engineer determines no reasonable alternate method is available, written approval of the Engineer must be first obtained.

[8] All work requiring men or vehicles within County rights-of-way shall comply with all applicable requirements of the Ohio Manual of Traffic Control Devices and Item 614 (Maintaining Traffic) of the Ohio Department of Transportation's Construction and Material Specifications manual, latest edition. Failure to comply with these requirements will be cause for immediate revocation or suspension of the permit until the proper traffic control devices and methods have been provided.
